General Hazards

Common kinds of danger in a warehouse setting are slips, trips and falls. Removing or placing things from storage could cause a fumble or slip, potentially causing both employee and item to fall. The potential for slips, trips and falls is increased when workers are moving things on different kinds of floor surfaces and on various levels. Another common hazard is getting hit by falling stuff. This is normally caused by failure to properly stack things on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries because of improper lifting techniques are one more common hazard.

Warehouse equipment carries inherent dangers. Accidents or injuries can be caused by hand trucks, forklift trucks and conveyors if they are not operated right. Warehouse tools, like for example pallets, skids, strapping and cutting tools, need to be utilized cautiously in loading, packing and unpacking.
